Mary Catherine Roberts was born in Rhinelander, Wisconsin. She was raised in Argonne and graduated from Crandon High School.

After high school, Mary attended St. Mary's School of Nursing in Wausau, where she graduated in 1966. It was at St. Mary's that Mary first came in contact with the Salvatorian Sisters.

In 1968, Mary joined the Air Force and became a career nurse. As a nurse she was stationed in Oklahoma, Philippines, Montana, Germany, Arizona, Texas, England, and finally in Michigan. During her time in the service, she earned her Masters Degree in Nursing Administration. Mary attained the rank of Major in the Air Force before retiring in 1988.

While living in Michigan, she was a home health care provider for Northern Home Nursing in Marquette, Michigan. Upon returning to Argonne, Mary served as a religious education teacher at St. Joseph and St. Mary's Churches in Crandon and Argonne. She was a member of the St. Mary's Parish Council and a Eucharistic Minister.

Mary went through the formation process to become a Lay Salvatorian with a small group at St. Nazianz. During this time she became ill and because of her illness she made her commitment at her home on April 29, 1995. A short time later, on June 29 of the same year, God called Mary home.

Her funeral services were held at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Argonne, Wisconsin. Mary is remembered fondly by the Sisters who were in St. Nazianz during her formation. May she rest in peace.
